

RPI TV – Business Meeting

Meeting started at 8:36 PM.

**GM Week:**

Michael Rahaim said the GM/PU 2006 Candidate Debates last Wednesday went pretty well.

Tony Furtado entered.

Andrew Clark explained that we missed a half hour of recording, and that Dan Ostrov and Eric Pratt are going to capture the DVCAM tape, splice it together with the archive file from the webcast, and burn it to DVD.

Eric Klauser asked where the DVCAM deck was. Andrew Clark says it's in Dan Ostrov's room. He was using it to capture tapes for the demo reel for the Accepted Students Activity Fair, and is keeping it to capture the GM/PU 2006 Candidate Debates.

**Accepted Students Celebration:**

Eric Pratt said the activity fair went well, we had two monitors, one showing Dan Ostrov's demo reel, the other showing clips from productions. Eric Pratt's monitor was in the middle showing a PowerPoint presentation with information about the club and clips from the GM/PU 2006 Candidate Debates. Mike Filippone came later and set up his laptop to show the Battle of the Bands.

**Pistols at Dawn:**

Andrew Clark said he won't be able to make this one, and that we need a crew for it. Andrew Clark said we need four crew minimum. He said the setup is just like The World This Week.

Andrew Clark said on this Saturday at 4:00 PM, Dan Ostrov will be taping the Doraj scene with extras. He said he would be there, Eric Klauser said he might be able to come.

Andrew Clark asked for crew for Pistols at Dawn. Eric Pratt said he might be able to. Andrew Clark said we'll have to work on a crew for it.

**Elections:**

Michael Rahaim said we have elections coming up two weeks from today, and that we had a few positions that weren't filled up this year, and would like them to be filled. Andrew Clark said Dan Ostrov didn't want to do it in the middle of the day because he wanted to have a full day of shooting before then, but to talk to him and see.

**The World This Week:**

Andrew Clark asked if we should take The World This Week slide down and give up on it for this semester. Eric Pratt said yes.

Michael Rahaim moved to open floor.

Andrew Clark reminded everyone about the runoff elections for GM tomorrow. The results are scheduled to be announced at 11:00 PM tomorrow night in the Rathskellar.
